

# Data File Testing

There are many different data sets that correspond with the services that provider agencies provide to clients of the North Sound Behavioral Health Organization. These data sets can be found at in the Data Dictionary found online at: <http://northsoundbho.org/datadict>. The transactions that are found therein contain the different record types of data that are exported from the provider data system and uploaded to the North Sound BHO SFTP site in batch files. There are different batch file types that are described in the Data Dictionary.

Using test data, include with your RFQ/P application the following batch files:

EDI/Native Transactions	<p>This file type contains most of the transactions that are found in the Data Dictionary. 837 Professional	<p>A file type that contains encounter data for the services that are provided. The data that comes in the 837 Professional is data that gets saved into the 120.03 Outpatient Services transaction. A separate 120.03 transaction is not required.</p>

837 Institutional	A file type that contains encounter data for freestanding Evaluation and Treatment centers. The data that comes in the 837 Institutional is data that gets saved into the 070.04 Inpatient Services transaction. A separate 070.04 transaction is not required. This transaction is not required unless the services provided are from a freestanding evaluation and treatment center.
278 Authorization Request	A file type that is used in conjunction with the Additional Authorization Information transactions to request an authorization for services for a North Sound BHO client. The data that comes in the 278 Authorization Request is data that gets saved into the 960.00 Authorization Request transaction. A separate 960.00 transaction is not required.

When submitting your RFQ/P electronically, you will need to include the corresponding files in the formats described in the Data Dictionary. The file must be exported from your data system.

Be sure that the data contained therein is test data and not real client data.

As a part of the RFQ/P evaluation process, your files will be validated in the North Sound BHO CIS test environment.
